Revolution on the Mountain

Onwards and upwards in LAAX: enhancement of the mountain infrastructure continues as part of the «Revolution on the Mountain» project. There are new slopes and parks to discover and you can look forward to an ultra-modern gondola for the 2014/2015 winter season.

New Pro-Line in the Curnius Snow Park

The snow parks in LAAX are unique and regularly host international freestyle contests. NEW: The Curnius Snow Park is now enhanced with a 520 m long proline with 4 kickers for the 2013/14 winter season. The intermediate area is also being extended in the IIs Plauns snow park, A bigger Olympic-sized snow pipe will be ready in time for the 2014/15 winter season.

Slope 50 from Alp Dado to Curnius enhanced

Slope 50 from the Alp Dado valley station towards Curnius has been extended and the route optimised. It is particularly suitable for beginners and less experienced skiers and snowboarders. NEW snowmaking equipment along the whole length of this slope ensures that there is always snow for an enjoyable run back to Laax or Falera.

Phase 3 of Revolution on the Mountain:


Replacement of the La Siala 3-seater chairlift

From the 2014/15 winter season, the existing La Siala 3-seater chairlift will be replaced with an ultra-modern 10-seater gondola. The extension of the Alp Sogn Martin route to La Siala has made a connection to the Galerie possible, allowing better access to the area around La Siala.

Wildlife quiet zones

port us - for the sake of the environment:

Wild animals like to spend the winter in quieter areas of the forests. In order to survive, it is important that they be left alone so they expend as little energy as possible. As well as the more familiar species, there are some rare birds, such as the seriously endangered capercaillie, blackcock and ptarmigan, which are parti-



cularly in need of protection. At the edge of the wildlife quiet zones there are relevant signs to indicate the areas and mark the boundaries. The wildlife quiet zones are shown on the map of the slopes.
