



## WHERE THE YOUNG WILDS FIND THEIR HOME

**A whole mountain in Davos Klosters is dedicated to freestylers'. On the Jakobshornbahn you will find a snow park, a half pipe and several mountain huts and après ski venues.**

Drag lifts are a necessary evil for most of the single-board snowsport addicts. Davos Klosters mountain rail & cableways have taken this to heart. Since the winter of 2011/12 all long drag lifts have been replaced by comfortable chairlifts. Jakobshorn, which has been geared towards snowboarders since the late 1980s, can thus strengthen its reputation as the snowboarders' mountain.

### **Unlimited freestyle fun**

The snowpark at the famous Jatz Hut has kickers and rails accessed by an own lift. So you can spend the whole day practicing a trick to celebrate having cracked it by evening. And anyone who still hasn't had enough freestyle sport can have a great time in the halfpipe on Bolgen, which is illuminated on Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday evenings. The superpipe is freshly prepared every Monday and Thursday and is always in top conditions.

### **Airbag at Bolgen**

At the foot of the traditional ski lift at Bolgen, the new airbag offers an additional treat for the freestylers. 4 kickers, diverse rails and an airbag measuring 15x15 are available to practice the jumps one always dreamed of trying.

### **Summit meeting of the top snowboarders**

The big names on the Swiss snowboard scene are well acquainted with the pistes and parks in Davos. Stars such as Iouri Podladtchikov and Markus Keller both went to the Davos Sports Gymnasium, where they laid the foundation for their sporting careers. Even today they return to train their tricks and jumps again at the foot of Jakobshorn.

### **Snowboarders already welcome in the 1980s**

Christian Haller from Zernez, another athlete in the Swiss snowboarding elite, doesn't only come to Davos for the O'Neill Evolution, but also always enjoys the slopes he's so familiar with. «Davos has the only halfpipe of this size in the region,» he says. That was why he came to Davos every Wednesday afternoon and every weekend in his schooldays. «This is where I learned to ride the halfpipe.» He returns to his second home, as he calls it, whenever possible. He's drawn not only by the pipe on Jakobshorn but also by the freeriding on Rinerhorn – the mountain rated by locals as an insiders' tip. Despite all the draglifts! Favourite downhill run.

## **Parks & boardercross in Davos Klosters**

Jakobshorn: Bolgen halfpipe (permanent, Tues/Wed/Fri illuminated)  
Snowpark with kickers and rails (at Jatz Junior)

Madrisa: Skicross & boardercross (at Blattegg lift)

Parsenn: Boardercross and kickers (at Totalp lift; dependant on weather)

Pischa: Kickers (at Mitteltälli lift; dependant on weather)

Rinerhorn: Small snowpark (at training lift)

Selfranga lift: Small snowpark
